

FIRST CALL FOR PROJECT PROPOSALS

BRICS Biomed Coorperation aims to augment innovation and product development in Biomedical areas such as Biotherapeutics, Biosensors, Biomedical Imaging, Cellular Technologies, Drug Discovery, Lab-on-a-CHIP, Medical Robotics, Medical Bioinformatics, Nanobiotechnologies, Nanomedicine, Pharmacogenomics, Personalized Medicine, Point-ofcare Devices, Regenerative Medicine, Stem Cell Technology, Systems Biology, Tissue Engineering etc.

BRICS Biomed Cooperation invites Brazilian scientists to submit a 3-4 pages proposal with 2 pages of CV (6 pages in total) as expression of interest before 15 November 2014.

The number of projects from one institution is unlimited. The proposal should include rationale, authors, address, goal, objectives, current stage of the project, required financial support for project completion, patents expected, number of spin-offs and expected time frame of commercialization. After the initial screening, selected scientists will be invited for the 1st International Meeting of "The BRICS Countries: Biomed Cooperation" followed by full proposal submission and funding.

In the CV, do indicate the number of patents, patents filed with title, cumulative impact factor, H-index, number of PhD/Master students guided with thesis title,10 most relevant publications, industrial collaborations etc.

• Brazilian Scientists living abroad and working in academics or industry, who are interested to set up laboratories in Brazil or in any other BRICS country, are invited to submit proposals


• Young Brazilian Scientists (residing abroad as well) who have completed their PhD are also invited to submit proposals
